Read the bible & discuss:

1. Read Ex. 19:1-4. Describe the journey that the people of Israel have been on up to this point in Exodus. Who is the God who has been with them?
2. Read Ex. 19:5-6. What are the 3 ways Israel is described and what do you think they mean?
