Read the bible & discuss:

Youth

- 1. Read Ex. 32:1-6. Give one word that summarises the attitude of the people.
- 2. Read Ex. 33: 1-3. How is God's grace as well as his anger displayed?
- 3. Read Ex. 40:34-38. What is striking about what happens here?
- 4. How does it show that the Lord is truly a compassionate and gracious God (Ex. 34:6-7)?
- 5. How does God's actions in Jesus show him to be the same God in Exodus?
- 6. What are you tempted to love more than God?

For Younger kids

- 1. What did the Israelites do that was so horrible?
- 2. What did Moses do when he came down the mountain?
- 3. God said he was going to destroy them. Did he destroy them all?
- 4. What does today's story teach us about God?
- 5. Who does God the Father want us to love and follow?
- 6. What can we sometimes love more than Jesus?



Give thanks for who God is & ask for help His help to follow Him the the one true living God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

This week's 'dance' challenge




- 1. Film a dance to the song "Jesus Number 1" by Colin.

Discussion:


- Who gave us these things?

Starting at #1, connect the dots to see what the Israelites made from gold.




Moses went to the top of the mountain where God gave him the Ten Commandments. He was gone a long time and the people began to think that he was never coming back. They gave Aaron their gold jewelry and he built an idol for them to worship instead of God.

THE GOLDEN CALF



Moses was up on the mountain speaking with the Lord for 40 days and 40 nights. The Israelites wanted a god to go before them, so they collected all their gold. They gave their gold to Aaron

and he made the gold into the shape of a calf.

The Lord told Moses to go down the mountain because the Israelites were not obeying. They had made an idol. One of the commandments was not to worship idols.

The Lord wanted to destroy, or kill, the Israelites, but Moses talked with the Lord. The Lord decided not to destroy the Israelites after all.

Moses went down the hill with the ten commandments written on two stone tablets. When Moses got to the foot of the mountain, he saw the people dancing and worshiping the golden calf. Moses got angry with the people and he threw down the stone tablets. They broke into pieces.

Moses destroyed the golden calf. Moses called out to the people, "Whoever is for the Lord, the God of Israel, follow me." Moses had these people kill the others who did not want to follow after the Lord.
