Who is Jesus?



Well, a guy called Mark wrote down an amazing and true story about Jesus.

Read the Bible & discuss: Mark 1

Younger kids:

- 1. What's something you can't wait to share with your friends when you go back to School?
- 2. Mark says that his book is good news. Who is this good news about?
- 3. Jesus is a very special King. What can you discover about Jesus? What kinds of things does Jesus do?
- 4. What do you think of Jesus?

Youth:

- 1. Even in a sports team, it is important to have a good leader! Can you think of a time where that has made a difference to a team you have been on?
- 2. Mark tells us 'up front' that Jesus is the Christ. The title 'Christ' means God's promised King. Scan through the chapter. What kind of King is Jesus? How does this make you feel?
- 3. What does the Isaiah quote (in verses 2-3), tell us about John the Baptist & the One that he is getting things ready for? Look at verses 7-8 too. What does John tell us?
- 4. What does John say everyone's problem before God is (verse 4)?
- 5. It's clear from what John says that Jesus does not have the same problem with sin that we have. Jesus is so special that John is not even good enough to untie his shoes (verses 7-8). If Jesus does not need forgiveness of sin (verse 4), why does He get baptised by John? Who does Jesus do this for?

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Youth questions continued:

- 6. What's the significance of the voice from heaven? What do we discover about Jesus?
- 7. What is Jesus' message (Verse 14-15)? How do people react to it? How do you want to respond to King Jesus?



Give thanks and pray:

Thank God for sending His special Son to us, our King Jesus. Thank God that we can be part of His kingdom. Thank God that Jesus is powerful, good and able to help us.

Ask God to help you turn back to Him. Ask God to help you turn from your way to God's way and trust the good news about Jesus.




