Last week in Exodus 7-10 we saw that God is faithful to His promises. He sends Moses to tell the bad king to let His people go and sends 9 plagues when pharaoh doesn't listen. One final plague is coming and we see that God rescues his people from slavery in Egypt and helps them as they escape!

How does God have to rescue His people?

**Read the bible & discuss:**

## Older kids read Exodus 15:1-27

- 1) How did God rescue his people from Egypt?
- 2) How does the song describe God and what he has done:
  - a) for his people? (v. 2, 13, 17-19)
  - b) to his enemies? (v. 4-19)
- 3) How do the people respond to God's rescue?
  - a) at first (v. 1-2, 20-21)
  - b) after 3 days (v. 22-27)
- 4) God's rescue of his people from Egypt solved their problem of slavery, but didn't solve the bigger problems of sin and death. How does God rescue them from this problem?
- 5) How has this grown your appreciation for Jesus as our Saviour?
- 6) Who is someone you know that doesn't know Jesus? How could you share this story of God's great rescue with them?

## Younger kids talk discussion questions

- 1) When is a time you have needed help with a big problem?
- 2) How does God help his people with the big problem of slavery in Egypt?
- 3) Why does God save his people from death during the Passover and when they cross the Red Sea?
- 4) How does Jesus save us from death?

**Give thanks & pray:** What would you like to pray for from the story? (e.g. use the teaspoon (tsp) prayer method, saying thank you (praise), sorry (repentance), and please (asking)).

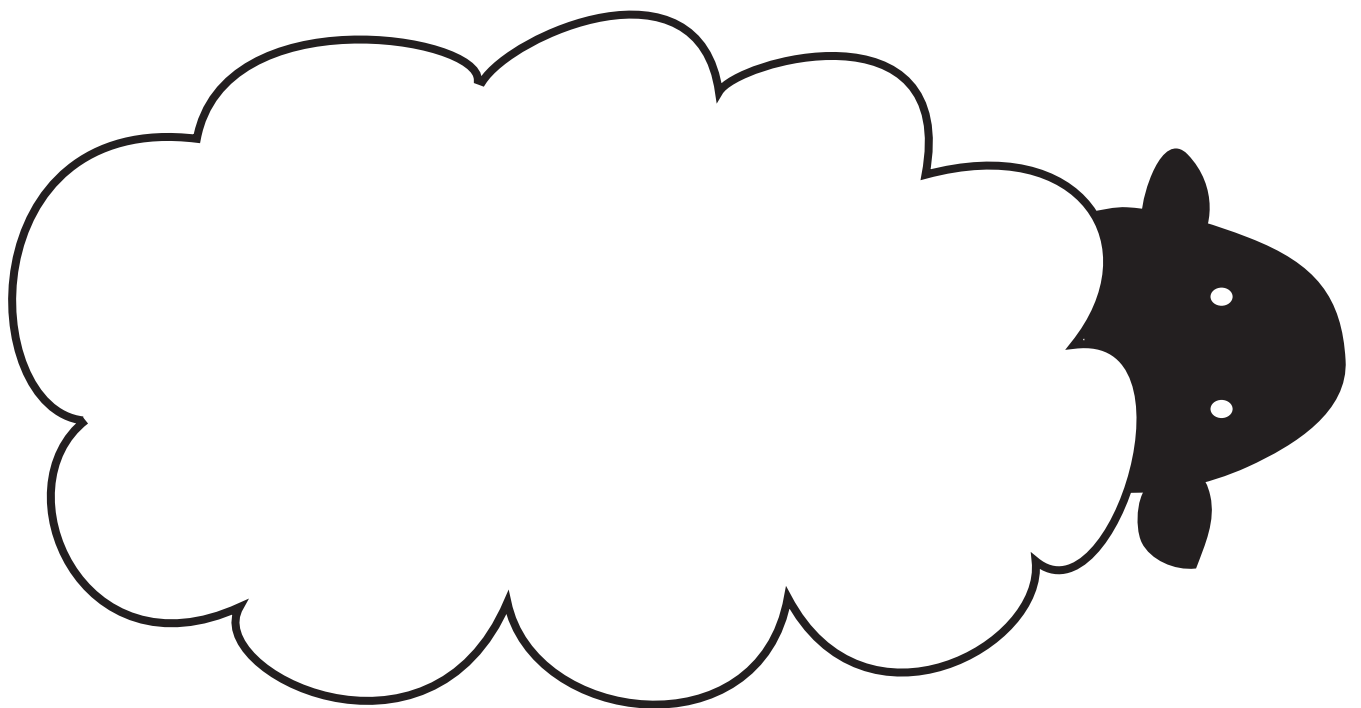
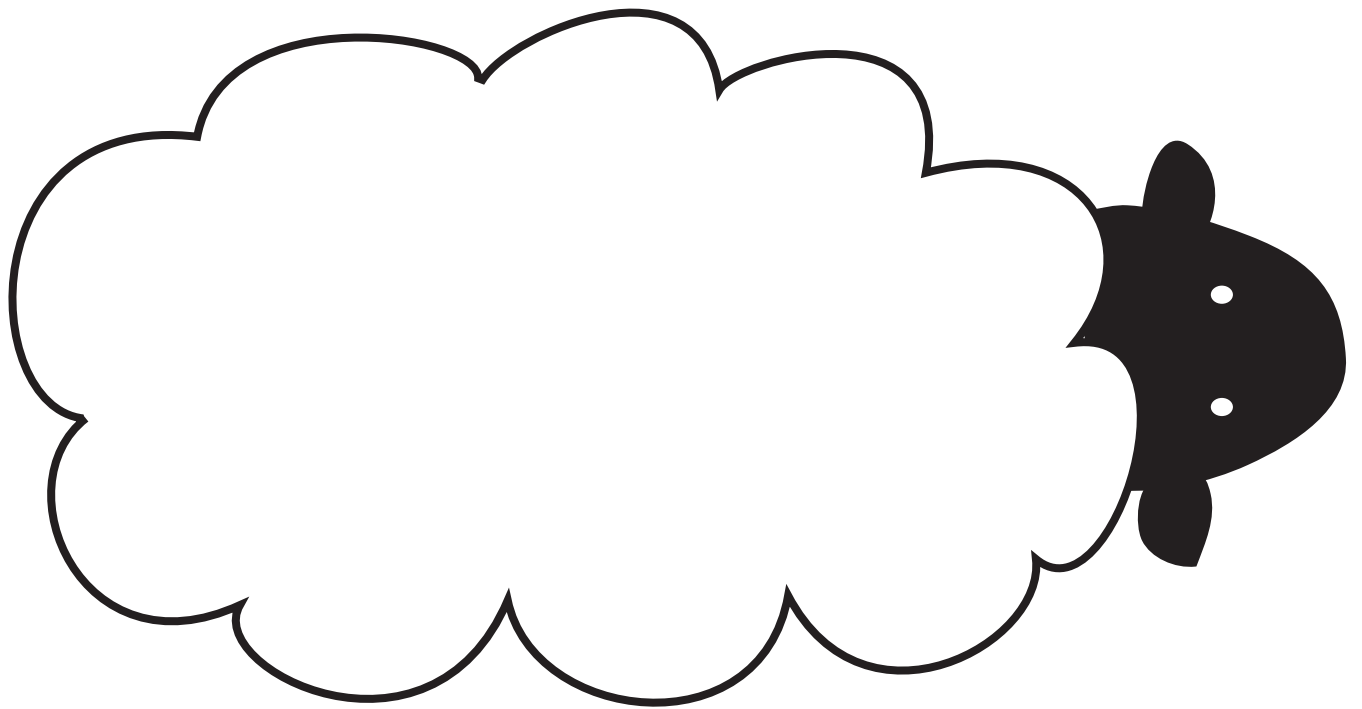
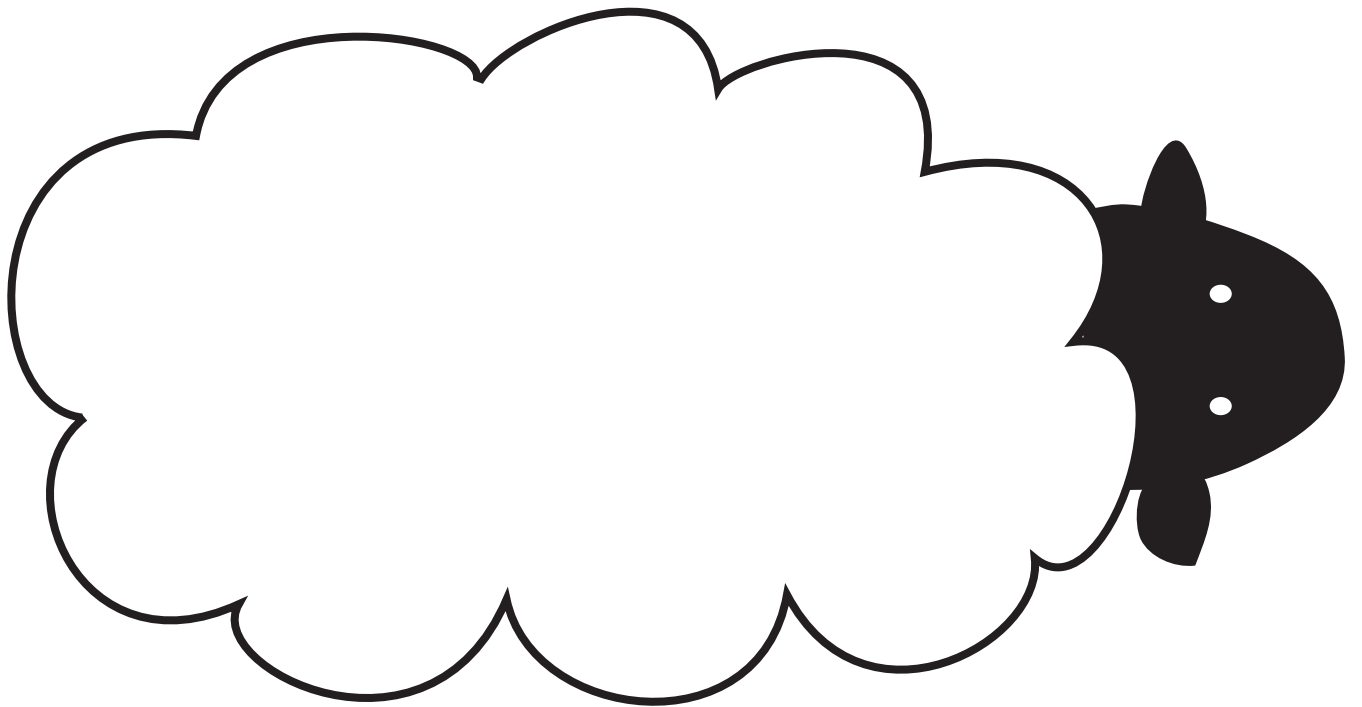
